Through the commissioning process, you will receive complete, organized documentation of your fall protection system for long-term use and reference. Some of the elements included in a commissioning record include:

The commissioning process is especially important for fall protection systems, since properly functioning systems can truly mean the difference between life and death.

Commissioning is a quality assurance process with a goal of delivering fully operational and optimized systems upon project completion. Fall protection commissioning begins with a review the owner's performance requirements and continues through performance testing as the project nears completion.

Even the most well planned and properly designed fall protection system can only function if it is installed and used properly. So, having trained professionals overseeing the entire process—from initial planning through construction and to final close-out—increases the reliability of your installed fall protection systems.
